Guidelines re. The use of Photographic / Video or Mobile Phone Equipment

Ellenborough TTC is committed to providing a safe and enjoyable environment for young people to play and compete in their chosen sport. Part of this is recognising that both Ellenborough TTC and the player's relatives will want to celebrate their success and promote table tennis while at all times protecting our young players. Ellenborough TTC therefore asks that everyone abides by the following:-

- Consent must be granted by parents / carers for the taking and publication of photographic and video images of their child.
- When consent is sought please use the permission form which is available on the ETTC's website and on the welfare section of the club noticeboard.
- Photography should concentrate on the activity rather than the person.
- Any concerns should be passed on to the Ellenborough TTC's Welfare and Child Protection Officer – see noticeboard for details of this person.

PHOTOGRAPHY AT EVENTS

- Anyone wishing to use photographic and/or video equipment at any Ellenborough organised event must first register their intent with the event organisers.
- Anyone taking photos must have a valid reason for doing so and should produce a valid Coach or Player Licence, be able to prove that they are related to a player or have an official Press Card.
- Permission to use photographic equipment is solely at the discretion of the event organiser. If granted, the organiser will issue a sticker for the day which should be worn at all times.
- Anyone not displaying their sticker will be stopped immediately.
- Any person using a camera or videoing during the course of an event may be challenged by the event organiser or referee.
- Anyone continuing to use photographic equipment after being warned will be asked to leave and the matter will be reported to Ellenborough TTC's Welfare & Child Protection Officer as soon as possible to allow further action to be taken promptly.
